- Physical Education/Human Kinetics and Health Education are applied science disciplines/subjects.
- The subjects are taught from the level of primary school to doctoral level at University all over the world.
- Physical Education and Health Education are West African Senior Secondary Certificate Examination subjects since many years ago.
- They are also Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination subjects with National Examination Council

CURRENT SITUATION

Physical Education/Human Kinetics and Health Education are offered in over 90% of public Universities and Colleges of Education in Nigeria

Some private Universities also offer courses in Physical Education/Human Kinetics and Health Education

Currently, there are well over 100 professionals who are at professorial cadre across Nigerian Universities and Colleges of Education

All students studying Physical Education/Human Kinetics and Health Education in the Universities and Colleges of Education gained admission only through JAMB.

OBSERVATIONS

- Physical Education and Health Education are not listed among O/L requirements to be considered for admission to study Physical Education/Human Kinetics or Health Education programme in any Nigerian University or College of Education.
- Physical Education and Health Education are not among Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) subjects.
- The two subjects are about the only long standing WASCE and NECO subjects that are currently not UTME subjects
- Candidates who chose to read Physical Education/Human Kinetics or Health Education are at disadvantage with respect to UTME subjects count.

- From the foregoing, it is humbly requested that Physical and Health Education is introduced and be included among Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) subjects.
- I wish to assure that professional resources abound for items development and other support that may be required from us.
